July 6th - 9th



Nature stimulates a child's curiosity. During this week, the children will have an opportunity to explore various aspects of nature. Other activities include nature walks and scavenger hunts. The children will also learn about the importance of recycling and water conservation.

African Safari


July 19th - 23rd
